All new wastewater connections are subject to the Rates, Rules & Regulations adopted by the Bastrop County WCID #2 and Regulations required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) on the abandonment of septic tanks.

§285.36. Abandoned Tanks, Boreholes, Cesspools, and Seepage Pits.

- (a) An abandoned tank is a tank that is not to be used again for "holding sewage.
- (b) To properly abandon, the owner shall conduct the following actions, in the order listed.
 - (1) All tanks, boreholes, cesspools, seepage pits, holding tanks, and pump tanks shall have the wastewater removed by a waste transporter, holding a current registration with the executive director.
 - (2) All tanks, boreholes, cesspools, seepage pits, holding tanks, and pump tanks shall be filled to ground level with fill materials (less than three inches in diameter) which is free of organic and construction debris.
